

Yotel: a new hotel concept at Amsterdam Airport Schiphol

There will be a branch of Yotel with 56 rooms opening in the terminal of Amsterdam Airport Schiphol. Yotel is an innovative hotel concept providing business class hotel accommodation at affordable rates. The concept has been specially developed for locations where space is scarce. The rooms are 7 – 10m² in size.

Yotel is scheduled to open its doors at the end of 2007 inside Amsterdam Airport Schiphol’s terminal after passport control on the second floor of Pier D. Transfer passengers will be able to enjoy a most comfortable stay here when staying at the airport. Departing passengers leaving very early in the morning can check- in the night before and stay at the Yotel until right before their departure.

Amsterdam Airport Schiphol is a leading AirportCity, a dynamic hub integrating people and businesses, logistics and shops and information and entertainment. It is a location offering its visitors all the services they require on a 24/7 basis. “We are delighted that Yotel will be opening its doors inside our airport terminal.
