

CleanEquity Monaco 2010

London, UK, 24th June 2009. CleanEquity Monaco 2010, the premier international cleantech event, will take place next year on 4th and 5th March. Winners and runners up of the CleanEquity awards are automatically guaranteed a presenting role at the following conference. CleanEquity 2009 award winners Cardia Bioplastics (formerly Biograde - Australia), Hansen Industries (USA) and Solar ETC (USA), will be welcomed back once again to present in March 2010.
